

# Macintosh Academic Technology Printer Installer

## Connecting to the Network

Installing the printers require your computer to talk with a server on the UF network. You will need to connect to the UF network using one of three methods.

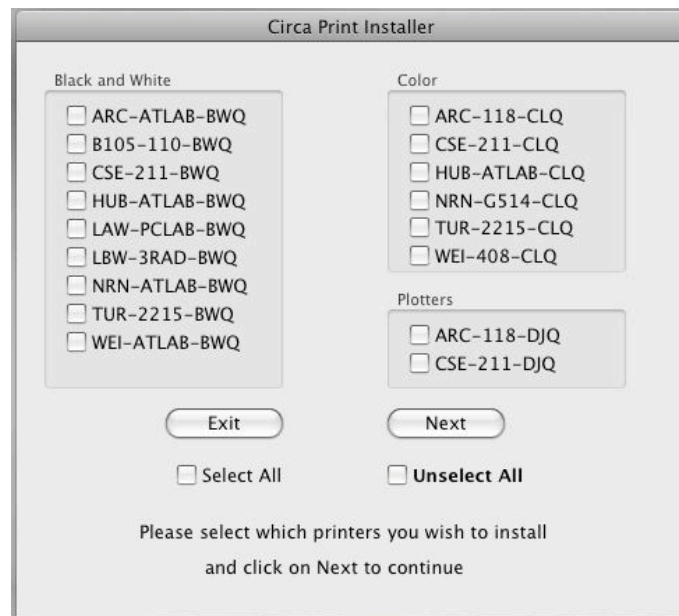
If you are on campus, there are some areas where you can use an ethernet cable and plug directly into the UF network.

The most widely used method is using the UF wireless network. Most laptops will connect automatically. You will need to open a web browser and login at the login screen that will automatically be loaded. If you have an older laptop that does not automatically connect, the UF Computing Help Desk (392-HELP) can assist you.

Lastly, you can use the Gatorlink VPN service which can be downloaded from (<http://net-services.ufl.edu/cgi-bin/vpn/vpn-clients.cgi>). This is ideal if you are attempting to install the printers from home, or an off-campus location.

## Installing Printers

After downloading the dmg image file, double click it and your Mac will automatically mount the image to your laptop. After the mounting is done double click it and run the application inside called "AT Printer Installer.app". This will bring up the following selection screen.

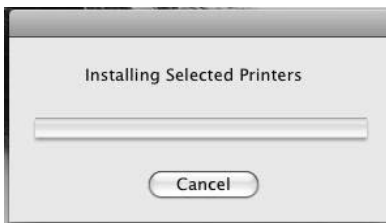


Select the printer(s) you wish to install or click the select all button. If you have a printer already installed, you will not be able to select that printer for installation from the list.

Upon clicking next, you will be able to review your selection and clicking back will erase all selections and allow you to start from the beginning.



You will see a progress bar that will show you the progress of the installation.



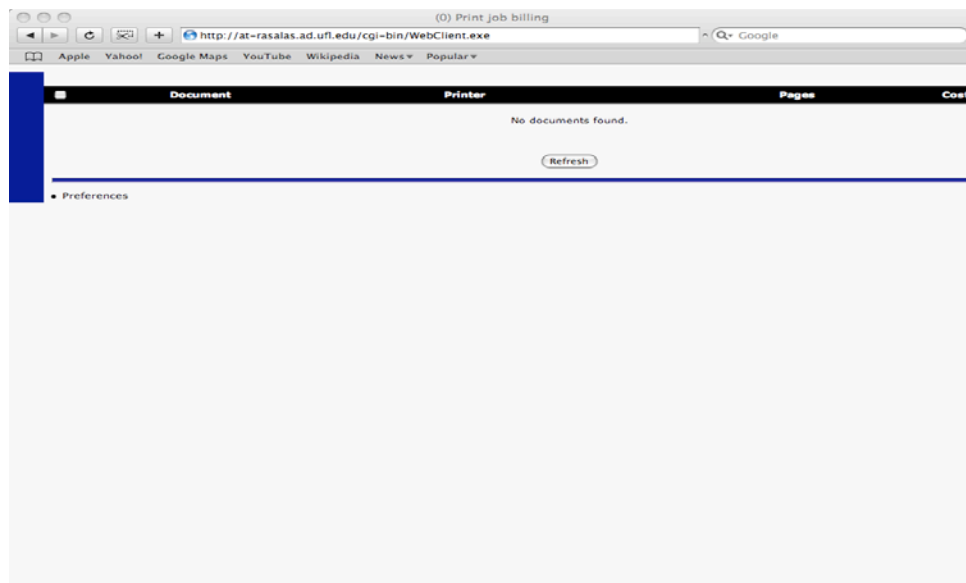
After the entire printer selection been installed you will see a screen similar to that of the overview. This screen will tell you how many of the printers have been successfully installed onto your system.



After the Installation is done and you have printed a document to the printer, if you do not have a User account set up to match your **GatorLink** information, you will need to associate the print job to your **GatorLink** account. To do this you will need to log into either **at-cetus.ad.ufl.edu** (*Bruton-Geer Hall, Building 105, CSE Building, Holland Hall, or the Hub*) or **at-regulus.ad.ufl.edu** (*Architecture Building, Health Science Center, Norman Hall, Turlington Hall, or Weil Hall*) .

Once authenticated into the webpage, you will be allowed to delete or send the print job to the **Print Release Station**. Once the selected print jobs are printed to the release station, the print jobs will now be associated with your **GatorLink** account.

**NOTE:** You will not be charged until the job is released from the Print Release Station



TO BE NOTED ABOUT THE INSTALLER:

Only the necessary drivers for the printers will be installed onto your system. All other files are localized into the mounted drive and will be deleted once the dmg image file is deleted.

If you have an issue where a certain set of printers (IE: color printers) will not install, please check to make sure that the driver has been successfully installed. **You will need administrator rights before any file can be placed onto your Mac.** The information you need is:
